Facility Report by Marcheta Madden, Temple Liaison Annual Meeting September 10, 2023.

The Temple has appointed a new liaison for the board to be in communication with, David Malmberg. We have also have two alternate contacts. David is easily accessible to all board members for emergencies.

David informed the board that the Temple has secured a new contract to complete all outside work on the building, hopefully by the end of this summer. Inside the building, old carpeting has been replaced upstairs, with the landing at the top of the stairs to be done in the near future. A thorough cleaning of inside rooms and open areas was also completed.

Future plans for the building include: fund-raising for beneficial projects to: cover the completion of the outside of the building; remodel the kitchen and update some of the appliances; remodel to create unisex bathrooms upstairs and downstairs; make the Temple handicapped-accessible by creating a ramp at the side door on the West side of the building, and then installing an elevator to run between the two floors.

It is understood by the members of the Temple that we as board members, volunteers and congregation members will always leave the building in the same condition as we found it.

Snow and ice removal was brought to the David's attention as an area that requires improvement, in particular having access from the street to the sidewalk for entry into the Temple building.
